The Neurosurgery Residency Program at the Keck School of Medicine of USC is a seven-year program that includes the intern (PGY-1) year. The intern year includes neurosurgery as well as other surgical specialty rotations. We have three residents per year in our program. The Neurosurgery Residency Program is comprised of 48 months of clinical neurosurgery, in addition to 12 months of electives, which includes sciences considered basic to neurosurgery. The electives year is followed by a final year as supervisor of residents at the medical center.
